- One year working as a Registered Dietitian (RD) or Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN). For an Entry level candidate, no experience is required.
- A Bachelor’s degree is required from an accredited college or university in nutrition or dietetics.
- Current certification as an RD or an RDN issued by the Commission on Dietetics Registration is required. An Entry level candidate must be RD or RDN eligible through the Commission on Dietetic Registration.
